Rock Climbing at Coopers Rock State Forest

Challenge your mind and body on the gritstone cliffs and boulders of Coopers Rock State Forest. Enjoy a full range of climbs, while being immersed in a bio-diverse natural ecosystem. Coopers Rock State Forest is one of the best bouldering and top-rope sites in the eastern U.S. The rock is a unique form of sandstone only found in the Allegheny Mountain region has a 40-grit texture that creates amazing friction and allows climbers to hold onto very round and bulbous holds. In fact, the rock at Coopers has been described as "...climbing a huge roasted marshmallow that is as coarse as sandpaper. Trained staff from Adventure WV of WVU cover the basics and help instruct participants as they climb. Try your hand and build skill with a range of routes – or encourage friends and colleagues as they try and reach the top. No experience or personal equipment is necessary for this activity.





Distance from camp: 31MIN / 18.0MI/

- 1. Start out going northwest out of the driveway for Emma Kaufman Camp/County Hwy-65/2 toward Summit Dr.
 - a. Then 0.83 miles 0.83 total miles
- 2. Take the 1st left onto Stewartstown Rd/County Hwy-65.
 - a. Stewartstown Rd is 0.4 miles past Summit Dr
 - b. If you are on Camp Run Rd and reach Mountain Vista Dr you've gone about 0.4 miles too far
 - c. Then 2.38 miles3.22 total miles
- 3. Turn left onto Point Marion Rd/US-119 S.
 - a. Then 3.07 miles6.29 total miles
- 4. Turn left onto Cheat Rd/County Hwy-857.
 - a. Cheat Rd is 0.2 miles past W Run Rd
 - b. If you are on Easton Mill Rd and reach Discovery Pl you've gone about 0.2 miles too far
 - c. Then 1.18 miles7.47 total miles
- 5. Merge onto I-68 E via the ramp on the **left** toward **Cumberland MD**.
 - a. If you are on Cheat Rd and reach Mid Atlantic Dr you've gone a little too far
 - b. Then 7.19 miles14.66 total miles
 - c. Take the County Hwy-73/12 exit, EXIT 15, toward Coopers Rock.
 - d. Then 0.36 miles15.02 total miles
- 6. Turn **right** onto County Hwy-73/12.
 - a. If you reach I-68 E you've gone about 0.2 miles too far
 - b. Then 0.99 miles16.02 total miles
- 7. County Hwy-73/12 becomes County Hwy-73/16.
 - a. Then 2.00 miles18.02 total miles
- 8. COUNTY HWY-73/16. Your destination is 0.2 miles past County Hwy-73/16
